Details:

Navigator Program: Provides information and support to newly diagnosed women with breast cancer. Navigator volunteers are matched to the newly diagnosed women to “navigate” them through the treatment process.

Educational Kiosk: Computer and printer provided in waiting room at the Smith Family Breast Center.

Women’s Cancer Fund: Provides financial assistance to women undergoing treatment for cancer. Expenses covered include: Prosthetics, wigs, mortgage and rent payments, utilities, child care, groceries, transportation. Helps patients focus on their treatment.

Mammography Assistance Program: Helps ensure that every woman who needs a screening or diagnostic mammogram can receive one. This program is supported by the generosity of groups and individuals within the community.
